Subject : The National Academy of Sciences, India - Science Teacher Award

Dear Sir/Madam,

Recognizing the importance of the role of teachers in promoting the overall interest of students in science, especially in the secondary and higher secondary stages, the National Academy of Sciences, India instituted an award, named 'The National Academy of Sciences, India - Science Teacher Award', in the year 1995-96, for the teachers of Uttar Pradesh. The aim of instituting the Award is to recognize a teacher every year, teaching science in High Schools/Higher Secondary Schools/Intermediate Colleges and other equivalent institutions, for distinction achieved by him/her in stimulating students to express their talent in and understanding of science, especially through participation in co-curricular and out-of-the-class room science activities.

The Award comprises a Citation and Rs.20,000/= (Rupees Twenty thousand only) in cash.

The Award would be presented to the selected teacher(s)* in a function to be held next year at Allahabad on the National Science Day, February 28, 2018. The Academy would bear the cost of travel of the awardee(s)* from his/her place of teaching to Allahabad and back, and hospitality at Allahabad.

The selected teacher would be expected to give a brief talk in the function.


The criteria for selection for the Award are appended.

You are requested to kindly go through the criteria carefully, and if in your valued opinion, a teacher of your 'institution/district' deserves to be considered for the Award, you may nominate him/her for the same. The Nomination form, complete in all respects and duly forwarded by the competent authority must reach the undersigned latest by February 15, 2018. The teacher selected for the Award, and his/her Head of institution will be informed by the end of the third week of February, 2018.

Criteria for the NASI-Science Teacher Award

1. The teacher, besides excellence as teacher, should have been actively involved in stimulating students to take active interest in extra curricular science activities and in innovation of teaching methods.
2. Success in stimulating students may be evidenced by the participation of the students under the guidance of the concerned teacher in extra curricular science activities, like Science Exhibitions, Students Science Congress, competitive items like Science Debates, Quizes, Essays, properly documented field studies etc.
3. Development and use of innovative methods may include development of apparatus, equipments or devices for science teaching, innovative and/or low cost experiments etc. by the teacher.
4. Active involvement in science popularization activities will be an additional consideration.
5. Teachers undertaking tuitions would not be considered for the recognition and **may not be nominated**.

Note

1. The Academy reserves the right of final selection of the teacher for the aforesaid Award. No appeal or protest in this regard would be entertained.
2. It is not necessary for a nominee to have participated/taken part in each of the activities given above.
