Select any one of the following topics stating its number:

1. Design the front cover of a book on Indian Trees. Incorporate the words 'Great Indian Trees'. Add the name of an author of your choice. Every attempt should be made to work in the paint medium only.
 2. Make a Repeat Pattern for a carpet to be used in a big hall. The motif can be geometrical or floral in nature. Use red, blue and one other colour.
 3. Design an inside page for a book of English poetry. Choose the first two lines of your favourite poem and put them down in a good calligraphic style. Draw a suitable illustration to go with the selected lines.
 4. Design an emblem for an NGO involved in spreading awareness about saving the tiger. Work in a circular format with an 8 inch diameter Or within a square measuring 7 inches by 7 inches. 'Save the stripe' should be incorporated in the design. Use Yellow Ochre and one other colour.
 5. Design a banner for the opening of a new fast food restaurant opening in your colony market. The banner should state 'OPENING SHORTLY' and 'FRESH N FAST'. Apart from this no other words should be used. The banner is to be put up at various popular points of the city.
